### Step 1: Gather your artistic team and community partners

What community institutions (libraries, university entities, etc.) might have a stake in the stories you are hoping to tell with this project?
<u>What community spaces</u> might be an ideal way to make this art accessible and in conversation with the community?
What financial opportunities (including local businesses) might be available to support this project?



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# **Step 2: Imagine a collective vision**



Appreciative Inquiry/Continued Asset-Mapping  Discover existing assets that you and your team could contribute to this particular project.

<b>Dream</b> about what <i>might/could</i> be for this project.
What do you want to walk away from this project having experienced and/or accomplished?

What do you hope community members walk away feeling, thinking, and/or planning to do?

<b>Design</b> what <i>should</i> be and how you will get there, with the support of community assets. With your current assets, how can you reach that dream for this project?
What is your action plan, and how can you share responsibilities?
What are your expectations for yourself, your collaborators?
<b>Destiny:</b> Implementation and sustaining.  How can you follow the action plan, checking in with yourself, your team, your community to track progress and adapt as needed?

What should be included in those check-ins to make them effective and supportive?



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
